AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A RECREATION BOARD WITH AUTHORITY TO REGULATE, EQUIP, OPERATE, SUPERVISE AND MAINTAIN PLAYGROUNDS, PLAYFIELDS AND RECREATION PLACES WITHIN THE BOROUGH; FIXING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD; ALLOWING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF TWO SCHOOL DIRECTORS AS MEMBERS OF THE BOARD; FIXING THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS; INVESTING POWER AND AUTHORITY IN THE BOARD; AUTHORIZING THE JOINING WITH SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN THE EQUIPPING, OPERATING AND MAINTAINING OF RECREATION PLACES; AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONNEL; ALLOCATING AND PRO-RATING OF EXPENSES; APPROPRIATING FUNDS TOWARD SUCH ACTIVITIES.

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville does hereby ordain and enact the following Ordinance.

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions and authority of the Borough Code of 1947, P.L. 1621 (53 P.S. 14901, etc.) the Borough Council does hereby create and establish a Recreation Board for the Borough, consisting of five members, to be appointed by the Council. The Council shall appoint as two of such Board members, two members of the School Board, who shall be recommended by the School Board.

SECTION 2. The Board shall be invested with all and full powers and authority as delegated to it under the Borough Code and with the right to improve, equip, operate, maintain and regulate public parks, playgrounds, playfields, public swimming pools and bathing places, indoor or outdoor recreation facilities, places or centers, established within the Borough.

SECTION 3. The Board shall be appointed and serve for the term of five years, or until their successors are appointed, except that the members of the Board first appointed, shall be appointed for terms of one, two, three, four and five years respectfully, so that the term of one member shall expire annually thereafter. Vacancies in the Board, occurring otherwise than by expiration of term, shall be filled, by Council, for the unexpired term of the vacated membership. The members of the Bard shall serve without compensation. Women shall be eligible for appointment.

SECTION 1. The Board, immediately following their appointment, shall meet and elect their own chairman and Secretary, who shall serve for a period of one year. The Board shall have the power to adopt rules and regulations for the

conduct of all business within its jurisdiction. The Board shall meet annually thereafter for the purpose of electing a Chairman and Secretary, to serve for the ensuing year, and shall meet otherwise as directed by their rules and regulations. The Board shall have the authority to select play-leaders, recreation directors, supervisors, superintendents, and such other officers, and employes as may be necessary or needed, to serve for periods as shall be permitted by the rules and regulations of the Board.

SECTION 5. The Board may, with the consent and approval of Council, join with the School District of the Borough, in joint venture of improving, equiping, operating maintaining of any of the facilities or recreation places, designated in Section 2 hereof. The costs and expense of such venture, to be allocated and pro-rated between the Borough and the School District, as shall be agreed upon by them.

SECTION 6. The Board is authorized and empowered to receive and expend such sums as may, from time to time, be appropriated to it by the Borough, the School District of the Borough, and by the State of Pennsylvania, or any of its departments or agencies, and to receive and utilize for the purposes for which it is created, any sum or sums of money or any property which may come to it from any source whatsoever.

SECTION 7. The Borough is authorized to appropriate, set aside and pay over to the Board, from time to time, such sum or sums, as it shall deem proper, from the amount set up and designated in its Annual Budget, for such purposes, and shall annually, in its budget, sppropriate, set up and allocate reasonable sums for the Recreation Board's activities.
