

ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE
FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1956

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville hereby enacts the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied upon all property and occupations of citizens within the Borough of Monroeville, subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1956 as follows:

(a) The tax rate for general borough purposes shall be nine (9) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

(b) The tax rate of debt purposes shall be one (1) mill on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Making a total tax rate of Ten (10) mills.

SECTION 2. The assessed valuation of property in the Borough and the occupational assessment for citizens of the Borough, used as a basis for taxation purposes, shall be that valuation fixed by the Board of Tax Assessment and Revision of Allegheny County.

SECTION 3. That any ordinance or part of ordinance, conflicting with this Ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
