

ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING GARDEN CITY DRIVE TO BE A THROUGH STREET; PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF "STOP" SIGNS ON FIELDSTONE DRIVE, LAUREL DRIVE, GREENLEAF DRIVE, EVERGREEN DRIVE, AZALEA DRIVE AND FIRETHORN DRIVE AT THE POINT OF THEIR INTERSECTION WITH GARDEN CITY DRIVE; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Monroeville as follows:

SECTION ONE: Garden City Drive in the Borough of Monroeville is hereby declared to be a Through Street for its entire length in the Borough.

SECTION TWO: Pursuant to the applicable sections of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, it is hereby provided that all vehicular traffic on Fieldstone Drive, Laurel Drive, Greenleaf Drive, Evergreen Drive, Azalea Drive and Firethorn Drive shall come to a full stop before entering the traffic lanes of Garden City Drive.

SECTION THREE: The proper officers of the Borough are hereby empowered and directed to have erected at the points of intersection of the above named intersecting streets with Garden City Drive, the type of "STOP" signs provided for in the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, so as to govern the movement of traffic from each of said intersecting streets into Garden City Drive.

SECTION FOUR: Any person operating a motor vehicle on any of the intersecting streets named above who shall enter Garden City Drive without first coming to a full stop, shall suffer the penalties provided in the Motor Vehicle Code for such offenses.

SECTION FIVE: Any ordinance or part of an ordinance that shall conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
