

ORDINANCE NO. 111

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TAKING, APPROPRIATING AND CONDEMN-
ING A SUBTERRANEAN EASEMENT FIFTEEN FEET WIDE, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A PUB-
LIC SANITARY SEWER BY THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE THROUGH THE PROPERTY OF
FRANZ S. BACKER AND SIDONIA BACKER AS IS DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE; PRO-
VIDING FOR THE TENDER OF THE BOND OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE TO THE OWNERS
OF SAID PROPERTY AND UPON THEIR REFUSAL TO ACCEPT THE SAME TO PRESENT THE
SAME TO THE COMMON PLEAS COURT OF ALLEGHENY; EMPOWERING AND DIRECTING THE
SOLICITOR AND OTHER BOROUGH OFFICERS TO DO ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO THE MUNI-
CIPAL EXERCISE OF THE ACT OF EMINENT DOMAIN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BOROUGH
CODE AS SUPPLEMENTED AND AMENDED.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and the Council of the
Borough of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority
of the same.

Section One: - The Borough of Monroeville by its Ordinance No. 93
finally enacted on May 9, 1957 did provide for the building of a sanitary
sewer to be constructed from the intersection of the old William Penn Highway
and Beatty Road to the confluence of Abers Creek and Turtle Creek, all in
the Borough of Monroeville.

Section Two: - Contemporaneously with the enactment of Ordinance
No. 93, the Borough Engineer at the direction of Borough Council prepared
detailed plans and specifications for said sanitary sewer which said plans
and specifications have been adopted by said Borough Council.

Section Three: - Said plans located the sanitary sewer within the
lines of a private road located on the property of Franz S. Backer and Sidonia
Backer and the construction of said sewer requires a right of way and ease-
ment fifteen feet wide in said private road and through the lands of Franz S.
Backer et ux in accordance with the following description to-wit: -

Beginning at a point in a private road on line dividing land of
H. A. Lersch and Franz S. Backer, which point is North 80° 34' East,
eight (8) feet more or less from the corner common to land of Lersch
and Backer; thence North 8° East, four hundred thirty seven (437) feet
more or less to a point; thence North 45° West, ninety-five (95) feet
more or less to the line dividing land of Backer and E. Nedrow, which
point is one hundred ten (110) feet more or less South 73° 14' West,
from the Northeast corner of said Backer land.

Section Four: - The Borough of Monroeville has attempted to negotiate for the right of way or easement for the sanitary sewer as described above with the said owners Franz S. Backer and Sidonia Backer but such negotiations have proven unsuccessful, and therefore does by this ordinance exercise its right of eminent domain and hereby takes, appropriates and condemns for sanitary sewer purpose the right of way and easement described above with the right to install therein a sanitary sewer and to enter upon the said right of way or easement from time to time to construct, repair and maintain said sewer.

Section Five: - This taking, appropriation and condemnation is for public use, welfare and benefit and is made necessary in order to protect the health and welfare of the citizens and residents of Monroeville by the providing of necessary sanitary sewers.

Section Six: - The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to tender to the said Franz S. Backer and Sidonia Backer the bond of the Borough of Monroeville in the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars and present the same to Franz S. Backer and upon his refusal to accept the same, to have the solicitor present the same to the Court of Common Pleas of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania. The solicitor and the other officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby directed and empowered to do all acts necessary on behalf of the Borough of Monroeville to fully complete the taking, appropriation and condemning of this right of way or easement including the instituting and/or defending of all actions by viewers, or otherwise, for the determination of such damages, if any, connected herewith.

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Section Seven: - All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed in so far as they conflict with this ordinance.

Ordained and enacted into law this 26th day of November, 1957.
