ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES, COMPENSATION AND BONDS OF THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FOR THE YEAR 1958

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. The officers and employees to conduct the business and affairs of the Borough in accordance with the requirements fixed by law, ordinance or resolution, together with their compensation for the year 1958, shall be as follows:

Borough Secretary	\$325.00 per month
Clerk	\$200.00 per month
Chief of Police	\$385.00 per month
Patrolmen	\$340.00 per month
Extra Police	1.55 per hour
Dogcatcher	60.00 per month
Building Inspector	\$325.00 per month
Sanitation Engineer	\$325.00 per month
Road Commissioner	\$375.00 per month
Road Workers - No. 1	1.60 per hour
Road Workers - No. 2	1.70 per hour
Road Workers - No. 3	1.80 per hour

SECTION 2. For the attendance at regular meetings of the Borough Council, the Borough Engineer shall receive a retainer fee of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars per meeting. For the performance of the duties provided by law, the Borough Engineer shall receive compensation on a quantum meruit basis.

SECTION 3. For the faithful performance of the duties of the officers for the year 1958, a blanket bond in the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars on each of the employees shall be required.

SECTION 4. Vacations shall be allowed as usual and customary.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
