

BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 142

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, PROHIBITING THE USE OF BOWS AND ARROWS WITHIN CERTAIN LIMITS IN SAID BOROUGH, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same;

Section 1. That from and after the passage of this Ordinance, the use or shooting on the streets, alleys, parks and other public places, or within a distance of five hundred (500) feet from any residence or building within the limits of the Borough of Monroeville, of any bow and arrow or other implement which impels with force an arrow or dart of any kind, is prohibited.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall not apply to any bona fide and duly organized archery or sportsmen's club.

Section 3. Any person violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, and for the second offense, not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, and in default of payment thereof, shall be sentenced to undergo imprisonment in the Allegheny County Jail for a period of not less than ten (10) days, nor more than thirty (30) days.

Section 4. Each and every violation shall be considered as a distinct and separate offence.

Section 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
