

BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 162

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 136 OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE ENACTED JUNE 10 1958 AND ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES, COMPENSATION AND BONDS OF THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FOR THE YEAR 1959.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same.

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 136 of the Borough of Monroeville, ordained and enacted on the 10th day of June, 1959, be amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1: The officers and employees to conduct the business and affairs of the Borough in accordance with the requirements fixed by law, ordinance or resolution, together with their compensation for the year 1959, shall be as follows:

Borough Secretary-----	\$357.50	per month
Clerks-----	\$225.00	per month
Chief of Police-----	\$423.50	per month
Patrolmen-----	\$374.00	per month
Police Sergeants-----	\$399.00	per month
Extra Police-----	1.65	an hour
Building Inspector-----	\$357.50	per month
Sanitation Engineer-----	\$357.50	per month
Road Commissioner-----	\$412.50	per month
Dog Catcher-----	\$ 66.00	per month
Road Workers No. 1-----	\$ 1.76	per hour
Road Workers No. 2-----	\$ 1.87	per hour
Road Workers No. 3-----	\$ 1.98	per hour

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective July 1, 1958.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
