ORDINANCE NO. 169

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITS OF BOROUGH
STREETS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. The maximum weight of vehicle and load passing upon and over streets of the Borough of Monroeville where properly posted is hereby limited to five tons gross weight.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ten (10) days.

Section 3. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
