

BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 181

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL VACATIONS OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough of Monroeville to properly compensate its employees with vacation time; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough of Monroeville to provide a system which would enable it to attract and keep the highest type of personnel.

THEREFORE, be it enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1. All those employees of the Borough of Monroeville who have worked from one to five years shall receive a one week vacation.

Section 2. With the beginning of the sixth year to the end of the tenth year, each employee who continues working for the Borough shall receive a two week vacation.

Section 3. Hereafter, after the tenth year as an employee of the Borough of Monroeville, each employee who continues working for the Borough shall receive a three week vacation per year for each year thereafter.

Section 4. Any Ordinance or part of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they shall be in conflict herewith.
