

BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 221

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE REGULATING AND LIMITING THE WEIGHT OF MOTOR VEHICLES TRAVELING ON THE PART OF THE OLD WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY, ALSO KNOWN AS OLD ROUTE 22, WHICH IS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF MONROEVILLE.

The Council of the Borough of Monroeville does hereby ordain and enact the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. That from and after the passage of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any vehicle which shall, together with the freight or carrying load thereon, be in excess of 15 tons gross weight, to travel and be operated over and upon the part of the Old William Penn Highway, also known as Old Route 22, which is within the boundaries of Monroeville, unless proper bond in the amount of \$10,000.00 is posted to compensate for damages.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons who shall be guilty of operating any vehicle in violation of the gross weight provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, by summary proceedings, before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of the Borough be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$10.00 together with costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of said fine and costs, shall be committed to the Allegheny County Jail, for a period of not more than 30 days.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they shall be in conflict herewith.
