

## ORDINANCE NO. 293

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 180 AND ORDINANCE NO. 256 OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FOR THE YEAR 1961 AND PROVIDING FOR HOLIDAYS."

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 180, of the Borough of Monroeville, ordained and enacted on the 12th day of April, 1960, and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 256, of the Borough of Monroeville, ordained and enacted on the 10th day of January, 1961, be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. The officers and employees to conduct the business and affairs of the Borough in accordance with the requirements fixed by law, together with their compensation from and after the effective date hereof, shall be as follows:

SECTION 2. No Borough Employees shall be required to report for work or perform any work on the following days:

New Year's Day  
Memorial Day

Fourth of July  
Labor Day  
Thanksgiving Day  
Christmas Day

In addition, road employees shall be excused from duty on Washington's Birthday, office employees shall be excused from duties on Good Friday, and the Police shall be excused from duty on Easter.

Should any of the foregoing persons be required to work on a day from which they have been excused, that employee shall be compensated at twice the normal amount of pay for a regular day.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be come effective July 11, 1961.
