

ORDINANCE NO. 299

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT, NO. 5-R. BY AND BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AND NORWIN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

SECTION 1: Upon the opening of bids for the paving via a certain soil cement process of certain streets and highways in the Borough of Monroeville, to wit: Cottage Lane, Mt. Pleasant Road, Hochberg Road and Township Road, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder for the supplying of the materials and labor for this work was Norwin Construction Company, a Pennsylvania corporation, whose total sum bid was Twenty One Thousand One Hundred Eighty Nine and no/100 (\$21,189.00) Dollars.

SECTION 2: The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the said Norwin Construction Company, known as Contract No. 5-R, for the paving of the said streets and highways of the Borough of Monroeville hereinbefore named for the total sum of Twenty One Thousand One Hundred Eighty Nine and no/100 (\$21,189.00) Dollars.

SECTION 3: Before the said contract, No. 5-R, shall be executed, the said contractor, Norwin Construction Company, shall file with the Borough Secretary a performance bond in the amount of Twenty One Thousand One Hundred Eighty Nine and no/100 (\$21,189.00) Dollars, and labor and materialmen's bond in the amount of Twnety One Thousand One Hundred Eighty Nine and no/100 (\$21,189.00) Dollars and certificates of insurance covering personal injury, property damage and workmen's compensation liability as required under said Contract No. 5-R.

SECTION 4: Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance that shall conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
