

ORDINANCE NO. 328

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 277 PRESCRIBING TRAFFIC AND PARKING
REGULATIONS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THEIR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville,
in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by
authority of the same.

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Article II of Ordinance No. 277
of the Borough of Monroeville, entitled "AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING
FOR TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THEIR
VIOLATION", be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Parking within the Borough of Monroeville is
prohibited in any of the following circumstances:

- (a) Parking on any Borough, County or State
Street or Highway between the hours of
2:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. However, the Mayor
and Chief of Police may from time to time,
after public notice, exempt certain streets
or highways from the limitations of this
sub-section upon determination that literal
enforcement hereof would result in a severe
and unnecessary hardship to the adjacent
property owners or occupiers.
- (b) Parking within FIFTEEN (15) FEET of a Fire
Plug.
- (c) Parking more than SIX (6) INCHES from a curb.
- (d) Parking so as to block a public or private
driveway.
- (e) Double Parking.
- (f) Parking on the traveled portion of the roadway.
- (g) Parking within TWENTY-FIVE (25) FEET of an
intersection.
- (h) Parking so as to block a cross-walk.

SECTION 2. Section 12 of Article II of said Ordinance No.
277 is amended to read as follows:

Any violation of any of the Sections or Sub-Sections of Article
II of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than
TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS; and in default of payment thereof, imprison-
ment for not more than FIVE (5) DAYS; provided, however, that said
fine shall be limited to FIVE (\$5.00) DOLLARS for violation of

Sections 2 (b) and 2 (h) of this Article, and TWO (\$2.00) DOLLARS FOR VIOLATION OF ALL OTHER Sections or Sub-Sections of this Article, if payment thereof is made at the Borough Police Station within SEVENTY-TWO (72) HOURS of the time of violation.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance, or part of Ordinance, conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
