

ORDINANCE NO. 402

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 330 OF THE BOROUGH SO AS TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY COMPENSATION PAID TO THE DOG CATCHER FROM \$100.00 to \$125.00 PER MONTH AND INCREASING THE BUDGET TO PAY THE SAME.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the members of Council of the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, that the cost of handling animals running at large in the Borough has been substantially increased; and

WHEREAS, The Council of the Borough deems it necessary that the Dog Catcher be properly compensated for the work performed for the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same:

SECTION ONE: That Ordinance 330 be and the same is hereby amended to change Section 1 thereof by increasing the compensation paid to the Dog Catcher from \$100.00 to \$125.00 per month.

SECTION TWO: That the increase so ordained shall become effective beginning the month of July, 1963.

SECTION THREE: That the budget for salaries for employees be and hereby is increased in an amount sufficient to pay the said increase for the remainder of 1963, from funds not otherwise appropriated.

SECTION FOUR: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.
