

## ORDINANCE NO. 421

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SPECIFYING ADDITIONAL PROJECTS TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE MONROEVILLE WATER AUTHORITY IN ORDER TO HAVE THE SAID AUTHORITY UNDERTAKE THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED SANITARY SEWER SYSTEMS TO SERVE A PART OF THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Monroeville Water Authority is an Authority organized and existing under the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of May, 1945, P. L. 382, as amended; and

WHEREAS, when the Authority was organized, the resolution of the Supervisors of Patton Township limited the project to be undertaken to the transportation and supply of water; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Monroeville deems it to be desirable for the health and safety of the people of the Borough to authorize the Authority to construct, maintain and operate a sanitary sewer system to serve the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is willing to construct, maintain and operate a sanitary sewer system to serve the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the same:

SECTION 1: The projects to be undertaken by the Monroeville Water Authority are hereby enlarged to include the construction, maintenance and operation of the Thompson Run Sewer, Lick Run Sewer from the upper terminus of the Thompson Run Sewer to connect the present Garden City Treatment Plant, the future outfall or collector sewer to be designed to service the area near William Penn Highway in Monroeville and such other sanitary sewer systems which the Authority is authorized to construct, maintain and operate from time to time by ordinance or ordinances of the Council of the Borough of Monroeville.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
