

ORDINANCE NO. 440

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER IN ACCORDANCE WITH PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS PREPARED BY THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, KNOWN AS THE ADDERLY SANITARY SEWER PROJECT CONTRACT NO. 6417-S, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. That a sanitary sewer line and attendant facilities be constructed to provide sewer services for an area of the Borough of Monroeville known as the "Adderly Section", near Broadway and the Pennsylvania Railroad tracks, and to connect the same with the existing interceptor sewer of the Allegheny County Sanitary Authority, all in accordance with the plans and specifications of the Borough of Monroeville known as the "Adderly Sewer Project Contract No. 6417-S".

Section 2. That the said sewer line be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications as prepared by the Monroeville Borough Engineer, which plans are on file in the office of the Borough Engineer, Municipal Building, Monroeville, Pennsylvania.

Section 3. Upon the opening of bids for the building of said sewer project Contract No. 6417-S, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder for the construction thereof was Joseph P. Decker of Bridgeville, Pennsylvania, whose gross sum bid was Eight Thousand Five Hundred Eleven and 20/100 (\$8,511.20) Dollars.

Section 4. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Joseph P. Decker for the construction of the said sanitary sewer project Contract No. 6417-S, according to the plans, specifications, conditions and agreements therein contained, as established and approved by the Monroeville Borough Engineer, for the gross sum of Eight Thousand Five Hundred Eleven and 20/100 (\$8,511.20) Dollars.

Section 5. Upon the execution of said contract the said Contractor shall file with the Borough Secretary the performance bond, labor and materialmen's bond, maintenance bond and certificates of insurance, as required under the terms of said contract.

Section 6. The provisions of this Ordinance and all contracts made hereunder are made pursuant to the provisions and authority established under Ordinance No. 431 of the Borough of Monroeville, enacted April 16, 1964.

Section 7. Any ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
