

ORDINANCE NO. 455

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF OUT-DOOR EXCAVATION AND CONSTRUCTION MACHINERY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 11:00 P.M. AND 7:00 A.M.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The operation of heavy construction or excavation machinery, such as bulldozers, high lifts, pumps, power shovels, back hoes, jack hammers or any other type of machinery which is inclined to cause noises sufficient to disturb the peace and tranquility of the general public or any portion thereof, shall be prohibited in the entire Borough of Monroeville between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall not be applicable in the use of machinery and equipment for the removal of ice or snow or for the use of machinery or equipment in emergency situations where there is an immediate threat of loss of life or property.

SECTION 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance or who shall cause or direct others to violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof before the Mayor of the Borough of Monroeville or any Justice of the Peace, pay a fine for each such violation of a sum not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution, and upon failure to pay such fine and costs forthwith, to be confined at the Allegheny County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION 4. Any ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
