

ORDINANCE NO. 466

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE TAX
COLLECTOR FOR THE COLLECTION OF REAL PROPERTY TAXES
LEVIED BY THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE FOR THE YEARS
1966, 1967, 1968 and 1969.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in
Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The compensation of the Tax Collector of the
Borough of Monroeville for the collection of real property taxes
levied by the Borough of Monroeville for the years 1966, 1967, 1968
and 1969 is hereby fixed and established as sixty-five one-hundredths
of one percent (.65 of 1%) of all such taxes collected at discount
and at face amount. For all such taxes collected at penalty due to
delinquency, the Collector shall receive five percent (5%) thereof.

Section 2. The Borough of Monroeville shall cause statements
for each taxable to be prepared and furnished to the Tax Collector
in such form as the Borough deems proper, showing the name and address
of the taxable as taken from the tax duplicate, the face amount of the
tax and the last date when such tax is payable at face amount, the
amount of discount and the last date when such tax is payable at dis-
count, and the net amount payable at discount. Such statements shall
contain such further information as deemed proper and advisable by
the Borough of Monroeville. All corrections of such statements due
to address changes or errors in tax duplicates, shall be made by and
at the expense of the Tax Collector. Should the Tax Collector deter-
mine not to use such prepared tax statements, then the Borough shall
furnish to the Tax Collector such statement forms in blank as are re-
quired under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 3. Reasonable and necessary utilities and telephone
service shall further be furnished by the Borough of Monroeville to
the Tax Collector, provided the office for the collection of such
taxes is maintained within the Monroeville Borough Building.

Section 4. All other expenses of the operation of the office
of Tax Collector, other than those specifically directed by the laws
of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to be paid by the Borough, shall
be paid by the Tax Collector.

Section 5. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with
any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent
of such conflict.
