

ORDINANCE NO. 475

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION AND REQUIRING ALL BOROUGH POLICE OFFICERS TO BECOME RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. The amendments to the rules and regulations of the Civil Service Commission of the Borough of Monroeville establishing the requirements for the offices of Desk Sergeant and Line Sergeant duly submitted to Borough Council at its meeting on April 8, 1965 shall be and the same are hereby approved.

Section 2. The Civil Service Commission is further authorized by additional regulation to require that all police officers of the Borough of Monroeville become residents of the Borough of Monroeville within one (1) year from their first date of appointment by Borough Council.

Section 3. The Civil Service Commission is directed to incorporate the amendments and additions to its regulations referred to in Sections 1 and 2 above into the composite of its rules and regulations adopted by it April 12, 1962 and approved by Monroeville Borough Council August 9, 1962 by Ordinance No. 364.

Section 4. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
