

ORDINANCE No. 489

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE REPEALING
ORDINANCE NO. 102 AFFECTING TRAFFIC CONTROL ON AND
ALONG GARDEN CITY DRIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council
assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 102 of the Borough of Monroeville, enacted
September 4, 1957, and entitled "An ordinance declaring Garden City Drive
to be a through street; providing for the erection of 'stop' signs on
Fieldstone Drive, Laurel Drive, Greenleaf Drive, Evergreen Drive, Azalea
Drive and Firethorn Drive at the point of their intersection with Garden
City Drive; and providing penalties", shall be and the same is hereby
repealed.

Section 2. Traffic control along Garden City Drive shall be treated
and regulated as all other streets in the Borough of Monroeville pursuant
to Ordinance No. 277, enacted April 11, 1961, empowering the Mayor and
Chief of Police to establish such traffic controls,

Section 3. All existing traffic controls, such as stop signs, parking
signs, traffic lanes, walking lanes, etc. on or affecting Garden City Drive
and the streets intersecting therewith shall, however, remain in full force
and effect unless and until otherwise ordered and directed by the Mayor and
Chief of Police pursuant to the said Ordinance No. 277.

Section 4. Any ordinance or part of ordinance ~~conflicting with~~
conflicting with any of the provisions of this ordinance, is hereby repealed
to the extent of such conflict.
