

ORDINANCE NO. 541

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE PROHIBITING THE USE, OPERATION OR FLYING OF RADIO CONTROLLED AND UNCONTROLLED POWERED MODEL AIRPLANES, ROCKETS AND OTHER FLYING OBJECTS.

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The use, operation or flying of radio controlled or uncontrolled powered model airplanes, rockets or other flying objects of a similar nature is deemed to be a public nuisance and a danger to life and property and is therefore prohibited within the Borough of Monroeville.

Section 2. The term "powered" when used herein shall refer to any such model airplanes, rockets or other flying objects of a similar nature that are given motive force to fly, either wholly or partially, through electricity, gasoline driven engines or other chemical means.

Section 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance or shall cause or direct others to violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction therefore before the Mayor of the Borough of Monroeville or any Justice of the Peace in the Borough of Monroeville, pay a fine for each such violation in a sum not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution, and upon failure to pay such fine and costs forthwith to be confined in the Allegheny County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

Section 4. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
