## ORDINANCE NO. 562

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE VACATING ALSAM DRIVE, CATHLEEN DRIVE AND SPANGLER DRIVE, UN-OPENED STREETS.

WHEREAS pursuant to the recording of the Alsam Heights Plan of Lots in the Recorder's Office of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in Plan Book Vol. 61, Pages 156 to 159, inclusive, certain streets were laid out and dedicated to the Borough of Monroeville, known as Alsam Drive, Cathleen Drive and Spangler Drive; and

WHEREAS it appears that none of the said streets have ever been accepted by the Borough of Monroeville, opened or used for public purpose; and

WHEREAS the said streets are deemed to be of no benefit or value to the public or to the Borough of Monroeville;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Borough of Monroe-ville under Section 1741 of the Borough Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsyl-vania, all of those certain streets known as Alsam Drive, Cathleen Drive and Spangler Drive, as laid out in the Alsam Heights Plan of Lots, recorded as aforesaid, shall be and the same are hereby vacated.

Section 2. In vacating the said streets the Borough of Monroeville hereby quitclaims to such persons, firms or corporations as may lawfully acquire title thereto under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, such interest, if any, as the Borough of Monroeville may have had in the same prior to the vacating thereof.

Section 3. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
