

ORDINANCE NO. 594

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF BRIAR CREST DRIVE AND PART OF KELVINGTON DRIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of Briar Crest Drive as shown and laid out in the Briar Crest Manor Plan of Lots, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in Plan Book Vol. 70, Pages 41-43, and in Briar Crest Manor No. 2 Plan of Lots, as recorded in said Recorder's Office in Plan Book Vol. 81, Page 40, containing a total length of six hundred (600) feet, more or less.

Section 2. The Borough of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of that portion of Kelvington Drive as shown and laid out in the Kelvington Estates Plan No. 2, as recorded in said Recorder's Office in Plan Book Volume 81, Pages 146 and 147, containing a total length of one thousand seven hundred eleven and 44/100 (1,711.44) feet, more or less, extending from the southerly line of Kelvington Estates Plan No. 1, as recorded in said Recorder's Office in Plan Book Volume 79, Pages 159-161, southwardly to line of property of J. J. Foltz.

Section 3. The Borough of Monroeville hereby accepts for municipal purposes all the storm water and sanitary sewers servicing the lots adjacent to the streets hereinabove described and located within the said streets' rights-of-way or adjacent lots, to be part of the storm water and sanitary sewer systems of the Borough of Monroeville. The grade for the streets accepted hereunder is hereby established as the existing grade, reserving however to the Borough of Monroeville the right to change such grade without liability to adjacent property or property owners thereof.

Section 4. The Council of the Borough of Monroeville by separate resolution shall more precisely locate the said streets and establish the existing grade at the center line in accordance with the "As Built" plan of the same submitted to and approved by the Monroeville Borough Engineer.
