

ORDINANCE NO. 610

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE ORIGINAL PAVING OF A PORTION OF WOODLAWN ROAD

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough Manager is hereby authorized and directed to cause the original paving of that portion of a street laid out and designated as "Woodlawn Road" commencing from the southerly line of Washington Street and extending southwestwardly for a distance of four hundred (400) feet, more or less, to connect with the existing paved portion of Woodlawn Road as the same is shown and laid out in the Plan of Westinghouse Airbrake Home Building Company, dated December, 1923, revised January, 1933.

Section 2. The said original paving shall be constructed within the confines of a forty (40) foot street right-of-way to be acquired therefor and shall be constructed to a cartway width of twenty-six (26) feet, with curbs on both sides, and according to standards of Monroeville Borough Residential Street Specifications. All work shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Monroeville Borough Engineer.

Section 3. The Borough Solicitor is authorized and directed to acquire on behalf of the Borough all necessary property and rights of way for the construction of the said additional section of Woodlawn Road.

Section 4. All costs and expenses for the acquisition and construction of the said section of Woodlawn Road shall be paid out of the Monroeville Borough Bond Issue Fund Series 1968.
