ORDINANCE NO. 620

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF OLD WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY AND HAYMAKER ROAD AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That traffic control signals be installed at the intersection of Old William Penn Highway and Haymaker Road according to the plans and specifications for the same as prepared by the Borough traffic consultants Miscimarra and Wooster.

Section 2. Upon the opening of competitive bids for the supplying of all necessary labor, materials and equipment for the said installation it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder was Lightning Electric Company, whose gross sum bid, including alternate No. 1 for stainless steel poles and arms, was Eleven Thousand One Hundred Ninety-one (\$11,191.00) Dollars.

Section 3. The President of Council and Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the said Lightning Electric Company for the traffic control signal installation as bid, including alternate No. 1, in the said amount of Eleven Thousand One Hundred Ninety-one (\$11,191.00) Dollars. The form of the said agreement shall be prepared by or approved by the Borough Solicitor.

Saction 4. All costs, charges and expenses of the said traffic control signal installation shall be paid out of the Bond Issue Fund - Series 1968.
