

ORDINANCE NO. 638

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER LINE KNOWN AS MISCELLANEOUS SANITARY SEWER CONTRACT NO. 6802-S, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF SUCH CONTRACT.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That a sanitary sewer line be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville to provide sanitary sewer service for an area of the Borough of Monroeville in the vicinity of Summers Drive, Brinton Road, Lynwood Street, Stepp Drive, James Street and Elmwood Street, in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Miscellaneous Sanitary Sewer Contract No. 6802-S.

Section 2. Upon the opening of bids for the building of said sewer project it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Gerald Vitale, Inc., whose total bid, based on quantities contained in said contract, was Thirty-eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-eight (\$38,778.00) Dollars.

Section 3. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Gerald Vitale, Inc. for the construction of the said Contract No. 6802-S for the said sum of Thirty-eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-eight (\$38,778.00) Dollars. Upon the execution of the said contract said contractor shall file with the Borough of Monroeville Manager a performance bond, labor and materialmen's bond, maintenance bond and certificates of insurance, as required in said contract.
