

ORDINANCE NO. 656

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY AND OLD WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That traffic control signals be installed at the intersection of William Penn Highway (U. S. Route 22) and Old William Penn Highway according to the plans and specifications for the same as prepared by the Borough Traffic Signal Consultant, Anthony F. Miscimarra.

Section 2. Upon the opening of competitive bids for the supplying of all necessary labor, materials and equipment for the said installation it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder was Lightning Electric Company, whose gross sum bid was Eleven Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-three (\$11,923.00) Dollars.

Section 3. The President of Council and Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the said Lightning Electric Company for the traffic control signal installation as bid in the amount of Eleven Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-three (\$11,923.00) Dollars. The form of the said agreement shall be prepared or approved by the Borough Solicitor.

Section 4. All costs, charges and expenses of the said traffic control signal installation shall be paid out of the Bond Issue Fund Series 1968.
