

ORDINANCE NO. 662

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG PORTIONS OF MONROEVILLE BOULEVARD AND STROSCHEN ROAD AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT THEREFOR AND FOR MISCELLANEOUS ROAD CONSTRUCTION ITEMS NECESSITATED BY THE WORK OF THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY IN WIDENING THE SAID ROADS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Sidewalks shall be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville along both sides of Monroeville Boulevard commencing from James Street and extending northeastwardly to Pitcairn Road and extending along both sides of Stroschein Road from Monroeville Boulevard northwardly to William Penn Highway.

Section 2. The said sidewalks shall be constructed within the respective road rights-of-way as made available by the County of Allegheny and shall be done according to the plans and specifications for the same as contained in the Allegheny County contract for improvement of Monroeville Boulevard and Stroschein Road.

Section 3. The said sidewalks shall be of a width of four feet where sufficient right-of-way is available therefor graded by the County of Allegheny to the same grade elevation as the adjacent roadway. Where sufficient ongrade right-of-way is not made available for the purpose of the sidewalks, the Borough Engineer may reduce the width thereof or delete the sidewalk entirely as conditions may dictate.

Section 4. Upon the opening of competitive bids by the County of Allegheny for the improvement of Monroeville Boulevard and Stroschein Road it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder for the Monroeville Borough items contained in the said contract was Trumbull Construction & Asphalt Company, whose bid for the sidewalk construction was One and 16/100 (\$1.16) Dollars per square foot, and, based on the estimated quantity of eighty thousand (80,000) square feet, came to a total of Ninety-two Thousand Eight Hundred (\$92,800.00) Dollars. The said Trumbull Construction & Asphalt Company, furthermore, was low bidder on all other Borough items contained in the said contract which, based on estimated quantities and including the sidewalk item, came to a total of One Hundred Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-five (\$100,425.00) Dollars.

Section 5. The President of Council and Secretary are accordingly authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Trumbull Construction & Asphalt Company for the Borough items to be done under the Allegheny County contract for improvement of Monroeville Boulevard and Stroschein Road and including sidewalk construction according to the terms of the said bid. Upon execution of the contract the contractor shall furnish to the Borough of Monroeville a performance bond and labor and materialmen's bonds, each in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$150,000.00) Dollars, as well as any other preliminary documents required under the terms of the Allegheny County contract.

Section 6. Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
