

ORDINANCE NO. 679

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE
 FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 178, ENTITLED
 "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES GOVERNING
 THE FUNCTIONING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH
 OF MONROEVILLE AND THE COMMITTEES THEREOF".

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville,
 in Council assembled, as follows:

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Section 1. Rule 11 of Section/of Ordinance No. 178
 of the Borough of Monroeville, entitled "An Ordinance
 Establishing Rules Governing The Functioning Of The Council
 Of The Borough Of Monroeville And The Committees Thereof",
 enacted March 8, 1960 and amended by Ordinance No. 325,
 enacted January 30, 1962, and further amended by Ordinance
 No. 510, enacted January 13, 1966, is hereby further amended
 to read as follows:

"Rule 11. The President of Council shall be
 an ex officio member without vote of all
 standing committees of Council. The standing
 committees shall be as follows:

1. Finance, Administration and Ordinance.
2. Public Safety and Property.
3. Public Works, Utilities and Recreation."

Section 2. Rule 14 of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 178,
 as amended by Ordinance No. 325 and Ordinance No. 510, is
 now further amended to read as follows:

"Rule 14 (b). The Public Safety and Property
 Committee shall, inter alia, have the following
 duties:

It shall be responsible for all matters
 pertaining to the administration of the
 Police Department, except as to those matters
 which are delegated specifically to the
 Mayor by law.

It shall make recommendations to Council for
 the regulation of traffic in the Borough.

It shall be responsible for all matters
 pertaining to fire departments within the
 Borough and for fire protection generally.

It shall, when requested by the Borough Manager,
 review applications for licenses or permits of
 any sort that may be issued by the Borough,
 and it shall recommend procedure and regulations
 for the handling and issuance of such licenses
 or permits.

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It shall be responsible for all matters pertaining to buildings, land and other property owned by the Borough."

"Rule 14 (c). The Public Works, Utilities and Recreation Committee shall, inter alia, have the following duties:

It shall be responsible for all matters pertaining to the construction, maintenance and repair of all public streets, sidewalks, bridges and storm sewers within the Borough.

It shall be responsible for all matters pertaining to the construction, maintenance and repair of all sanitary sewers and appliances and sewage treatment plants within the Borough.

It shall be responsible for all matters pertaining to all utilities offering water, gas, electricity, communications and transportation services within the Borough.

It shall be responsible for all matters relating to recreation, parks and playgrounds owned, leased, supervised or equipped by the Borough, and shall be represented on the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board.

It shall be responsible for all matters relating to public libraries, and shall be represented on the Monroeville Library Board."

"Rule 14 (d). Repealed."

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective the 13th day of January, 1970.

Section 4. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
