

ORDINANCE NO. 709

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE REVISION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS ON MONROEVILLE BOULEVARD AND THE INSTALLATION OF TWO FLASHING SCHOOL SIGNALS ON NORTHERN PIKE AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF CONTRACT NO. 70-TS-5 FOR THE REVISIONS AND INSTALLATION OF SUCH SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That traffic signals along Monroeville Boulevard be revised, and that two flashing school signals be installed on Northern Pike in the vicinity of Northern Pike School in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Contract No. 70-TS-5.

Section 2. In the opening of bids for the said traffic signal revisions and school signal installations, it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Lightning Electric Company, whose total bid for Items I through IV based on quantities contained in said Contract was Four Thousand Six Hundred (\$4,600.00) Dollars.

Section 3. The proper officers of the Borough are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Lightning Electric Company for the traffic signal revisions and flashing school signal installations under said Contract No. 70-TS-5 for the sum of Four Thousand Six Hundred (\$4,600.00) Dollars. Upon the execution of the said contract, said Contractor shall file with the Borough Engineer a performance bond, labor and materials bond, maintenance bond and certificates of insurance as required by the said contract.
