

ORDINANCE NO. 717

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 611 BY ESTABLISHING UNIFORM MANDATORY COLLECTION CHARGES FOR THE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND OTHER REFUSE AND DEBRIS FROM ONE AND TWO FAMILY DWELLINGS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 611 enacted August 13, 1968, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. CHARGES FOR COLLECTION. For the service, by the Borough or its contractor, of collection and disposal of the contents of three or less garbage cans of the size and under the circumstances as set forth above approximately once per week, each person as defined above occupying one and two family dwellings shall pay to the Borough a mandatory fee, whether or not such person claims to use the service, the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars per quarter year, commencing upon the enactment of this ordinance. The Borough Manager shall establish reasonable and appropriate procedures for billing and collection and for the proration of charges for partial periods. The Manager may discontinue service to any person whose payment is not received within thirty (30) days from the date of billing."

Section 2. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
