

ORDINANCE NO. 752

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE  
IMPOSING A CHARGE FOR FALSE ALARMS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville,  
in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. DEFINITIONS. Wherever the following terms  
are used in this Ordinance they shall be defined as follows:

a. Alarm Systems - Any alarm system which alerts the  
Monroeville Police Department directly or indirectly to a  
burglary, attempted burglary, breaking, breaking and entering,  
trespassing, or other act for which it is designed to initiate  
a police investigation.

b. Subscriber - An owner or lessor of premises equipped  
with an alarm system which alerts the Monroeville Police  
Department either directly or through a third party.

c. False Alarm - An alert by an alarm system transmitted  
to the Monroeville Police Department, which, upon investigation,  
discloses that no burglary, attempted burglary, breaking, breaking  
and entering, or other acts for which it is designed to initiate  
police investigation or action is in process or has occurred.

d. Charge - An amount assessed a subscriber protected  
by such alarm system for a false alarm only.

Section 2. IMPOSITION OF CHARGE. Whenever a false alarm  
shall be received from a subscriber served by an alarm system, a  
charge of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars shall be made. Such charge  
may be enforced in the manner of a Municipal Claim.

Section 3. Any Ordinance or part thereof in conflict  
with this Ordinance is repealed to the extent of such conflict.
