

ORDINANCE NO. 774

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWER LINES KNOWN AS TYLER STREET SANITARY SEWER CONTRACT NO. 7105-S, AND GRANDVIEW SANITARY SEWER PROJECT CONTRACT NO. 7106-S, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF SUCH CONTRACTS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That a sanitary sewer line be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville to provide sanitary sewer service for an area of the Borough of Monroeville on Tyler Street, in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Tyler Street Sanitary Sewer Project Contract No. 7105-S,

Section 2. That a sanitary sewer line be constructed by the Borough of Monroeville to provide sanitary sewer service for an area of the Borough of Monroeville on Grandview Street, in accordance with plans and specifications therefor known as Grandview Sanitary Sewer Project Contract No. 7106-S.

Section 3. Upon the opening of the bids for the building of the Tyler Street Sanitary Sewer Project Contract No. 7105-S it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was William H. O'Brien & Son, Inc., whose total bid, based on quantities contained in said contract, was Sixty Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-five (\$60,575.00) Dollars, with completion by March 10, 1972.

Section 4. Upon the opening of bids for the building of Grandview Sanitary Sewer Project Contract No. 7106-S it appeared that the lowest responsible bidder therefor was Frank Rizzi, Inc., whose total bid, based on quantities contained in said contract, was One Hundred Thirty Thousand One Hundred Twenty-five (\$130,125.00) Dollars, with completion by May 19, 1972.

Section 5. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with William H. O'Brien & Son, Inc., for the construction of the said Contract No. 7105-S for the said sum of Sixty Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-five (\$60,575.00) Dollars, and are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Frank Rizzi Inc., for the construction of the said Contract No. 7106-S for the said sum of One Hundred Thirty Thousand One Hundred Twenty-five (\$130,125.00) Dollars. Upon the execution of the said contracts, said contractors shall file with the Monroeville Borough Manager performance bonds, labor and materialmen's bonds, maintenance bonds and certificates of insurance, as required in the said contracts.
