

ORDINANCE NO. 795

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REAPPORTIONING THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AND CHANGING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINES OF THE WARDS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania provides that each municipality having a governing body not entirely elected at large shall reapportion by its governing body into election districts composed of compact and contiguous territory as nearly equal in population as practicable, for the purpose of describing the districts for those not elected at large; and

WHEREAS, the United States Census Bureau has released its official census for the year 1970, which census fixes the population of the Borough of Monroeville at 23,802; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Monroeville has heretofore been divided into seven wards with a population as follows:

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the decisions of the United States Supreme Court, the Borough of Monroeville has formed a Reapportionment Committee which Committee reviewed the applicable census figures and submitted a plan dividing the Borough of Monroeville into seven wards, maintaining the existing ward boundary lines as close to their present lines as is physically possible; and

WHEREAS, the division of the population in the seven wards is as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. That the Council of the Borough of Monroeville hereby re-apportions the Borough of Monroeville into seven wards, such division as shown on the plan attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and made part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That the present Councilmen serving for the previously existing seven wards shall remain in office, and shall hold such office for the term for which each was elected.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not affect the present wards or election districts therein until the primary elections of 1973.

Section 4. That a copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Director of the County Board of Elections.
