

ORDINANCE NO. 852

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF HEAVY EQUIPMENT AND TRAFFIC SIGNALS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are directed to enter into a contract with Highway Truck Sales for a garbage truck pursuant to its low bid of August 14, 1973, of Thirty-one Thousand and no/100 (\$31,000.00) Dollars.

Section 2. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby directed to enter into a contract with Ateco Equipment Company for the purchase of three (3) refuse packer bodies pursuant to its low bid of August 14, 1973, in the amount of Forty-two Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-eight and no/100 (\$42,478.00) Dollars.

Section 3. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby directed to enter into a contract with T. C. Woomer Company, Inc. for the purchase of four (4) hopper-type spreaders pursuant to its low bid of August 14, 1973, of Ten Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-six and no/100 (\$10,666.00) Dollars.

Section 4. The proper officers of the Borough of Monroeville are hereby directed to enter into contracts with Traffic Control & Engineering Company for traffic signals at (1) Monroeville Boulevard and Stroschein Road, Contract No. 73-TS-3, pursuant to its low bid of July 10, 1973 in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty (\$15,920.00) Dollars; (2) Monroeville Boulevard, Northern Pile and Borough Building, Contract No. 73-TS-4, pursuant to its low bid of July 10, 1973 in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Four Hundred Sixteen and Thirty-six One Hundredths (\$15,416.36) Dollars; (3) Haymaker Road, Rush Valley, Ramsey Road and Leslie Road, Contract No. 73-TS-6, pursuant to its low bid of July 10, 1973 in the amount of Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-two (\$18,942.00) Dollars.
