ORDINANCE NO. 867

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 458, ESTABLISHING THE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND PARKS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 458 of the Borough of Monroeville is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. MEMBERSHIP OF RECREATION AND PARKS ADVISORY BOARD.

The Recreation and Parks Advisory Board shall consist of thirteen members appointed by Monroeville Borough Council. There shall be one member from each of the seven wards of the Borough of Monroeville; an eighth member, who is a member of Monroeville Borough Council; a ninth member, who is a member of the Gateway School Board, but who resides in the Borough of Monroeville; a tenth member who is a senior citizen, defined as 60 years of age or older; an eleventh member who is a teenager; and a twelfth and thirteenth member appointed at large from the Borough of Monroeville. All appointments shall be for three-year terms except the senior citizen and teenage member who shall be appointed for a one-year term. The members of the existing Advisory Board shall continue to serve their present terms. All new members shall serve until January, 1977 if appointed for a three-year term, or January, 1975 if appointed for a one-year term. The members of the Board who represent Monroeville Borough Council and the Gateway School Board shall not have voting power. Those members of the Advisory Board appointed from the Gateway School Board and from the Monroeville Borough Council shall have their terms as members of the Advisory Board terminate should they for any reason cease to be members of the bodies which they represent. All appointments to the Recreation and Parks Advisory Board shall be made at the regular meeting of Monroeville Borough Council in January of each new year.

Section 2. Section 5, Paragraph (4), is amended to read as follows:

Section 5. POWERS AND DUTIES OF DIRECTOR.

(4) Maintain programs of instruction for Monroeville Borough citizens in leisure time activities, and in the case of programs at adult level, to establish and collect fees therefor, sufficient to pay cost of instruction except that there shall be no fees charged or collected for adult level

Leisure time activities from senior citizens who reside in the Borough of Monroeville, defined as those individuals 60 years of age or older who are bona fide residents of Monroeville.
