

ORDINANCE NO. 893

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE 848 REGULATING TRAFFIC, PARKING AND IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Article II shall be amended by the following Section 12:

"Section 12. It shall be unlawful for any person operating a motor vehicle to pass or overtake another motor vehicle traveling in the same direction as the vehicle passing or overtaking in any area designated as a "no passing zone". Any such area so designated shall be marked with "no passing" or "no passing zone" signs, placed in conspicuous locations in the "no passing zone". Said "no passing" or "no passing zone" signs shall be placed in conspicuous places, a distance not exceeding one-eighth (1/8) mile from the beginning of the "no passing zone" through the end of said zone.

"Pass" shall be defined as follows:

A vehicle, or combination of vehicles, shall be deemed to pass another vehicle, or combination of vehicles when all of the vehicle and its load, or all of the combination of vehicles and their loads, moves by or in advance of such other moving vehicle and its load, or combination of vehicles and their loads, being operated in the same direction as the passing vehicle, or combination of vehicles.

"Overtake" shall be defined as follows:

A vehicle, or combination of vehicles, shall be deemed to overtake another vehicle, or combination of vehicles, when all of the vehicle and its load, or all of the combination of vehicles and their loads, move so that any part of the vehicle or its load, or any part of the combination of vehicles or their loads, is opposite to or alongside of such other moving vehicle or its load, or combination of vehicles or their loads, being operated in the same direction as the overtaking vehicle or combination of vehicles.

No passing zones shall be designated with appropriate signs. The following are no passing zones on the Borough of Monroeville Streets:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Direction</u>	<u>Designated Portion</u>
Old William Penn	East & West	Entire Length

Any person who shall violate any provision of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay fine of not more than \$50.00 and cost of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days"

Section 2. Article III of Ordinance 848 shall be amended to include the following Section 3(a):

"It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle upon any sidewalk in the Borough. Any such sidewalk may be so designated by appropriate sign. Any person who shall violate any provision of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$25.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days."
