

ORDINANCE NO. 961

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE PROPER BOROUGH OFFICIALS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF PENNSYLVANIA TO PROVIDE FOR A SUPPORT WIRE FOR A TRAFFIC SIGNAL DETECTOR ATTACHMENT TO A POLE IN THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, that an agreement with The Bell Telephone Company of Pennsylvania, providing for a support wire for a traffic signal detector attachment to one pole in the Borough of Monroeville, a copy of which is hereto attached and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby approved and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the same on behalf of the Borough.
