

ORDINANCE NO. 1086

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
REGULATING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF
HELICOPTER LANDING SITES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in
Council assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS

- A. Helicopter Landing Site
Any Heliport, Helistop, Helipad or any other
surface used or usable for helicopter operations.

SECTION 2. PERMIT REQUIRED

- A. It shall be unlawful to takeoff or land a
helicopter anywhere within Monroeville except
at a site for which an approval and/or permit
has been issued by the Municipality and is in
compliance with all applicable laws, regulations
and ordinances unless such landing or takeoff is
done:
1. In conjunction with a special event such
as an athletic contest, a holiday celebration,
parade or similar activity after advance notice
has been given to Monroeville's police of the
intention to do so.
 2. Other necessary for law enforcement purposes
and emergencies.
 3. With written approval of Monroeville Municipal
Council.

SECTION 3. ISSUANCE OF PERMITS

- A. Permits for establishing and maintaining Helicopter
Landing Sites shall be issued to the applicant only
after written application filed with the proper
Municipal Official and submission of proof that:
1. The site is properly zoned for the contemplated
use.
 2. The site has been inspected and approved by the
Bureau of Aviation of the Pennsylvania Department
of Transportation as complying with PennDot Bureau
of Aviation approach corridors, design and other
safety criteria.

3. The site has received such approval and clearance from the Federal Aviation Administration as may be required by the Federal Aviation Regulations.
4. All safety and fire protection facilities are installed in accordance with applicable laws, regulations and ordinances with consideration being given to recommendations from Municipal Employees having qualification concerning such matters.
5. Compliance with all conditions of approval prior to use of heliport.

SECTION 4. REVOCATION OF PERMIT - The permit shall be revoked if:

- A. PennDot Bureau of Aviation revokes the license or refuses to relicense the Site after one of its periodic inspections (which inspections are made not less frequently than annually),
- B. The Federal Aviation Administration withdraws or revokes its approval or clearance.
- C. The Municipality has notified the permit holder in writing that the site is no longer in compliance with conditions of approval, applicable laws and ordinances.

SECTION 5. PROCEDURE AFTER REVOCATION

- A. When the approval or permit has been revoked the owner, lessee and/or applicant shall immediately close the site to all helicopter operation by publishing such notices and warnings as necessary to accomplish such purpose.

SECTION 6. PENALTIES

- A. Anyone who operates a heliport in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction by a District Magistrate pay a fine not more than \$100.00 for each violation. Each day that any such heliport site is not in compliance with conditions of approval or applicable laws or ordinances shall be deemed a separate violation.

SECTION 7. REPEALER

A. Any ordinance or part thereof which conflicts with any of the terms of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.
