

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1076 SECTION 4 PROVIDING
REVENUE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE BY
IMPOSING A MERCANTILE LICENSE AND TAX ON PERSONS
ENGAGING IN CERTAIN OCCUPATIONS AND BUSINESSES

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows pursuant to the authority of the Act of December 31, 1966 P.L. 511 and the Act of April 13, 1972 P.L. 62, known as the Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law.

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1076, Section 4, is hereby amended to read as follows:

IMPOSITION AND RATE OF TAX. Every persons engaged in any of the following occupations or businesses in the Municipality shall pay an annual mercantile license tax for each license year at the rate set forth:

(a) Wholesale vendors or dealers in goods, wares and merchandise, at the rate of one and one-half (1-1/2) mills on each dollar of the volume of the annual gross business transacted by him.

(b) Retail vendors or dealers in goods, wares and merchandise, all persons engaged in conducting restaurants or other places where food, drink or refreshments are sold, whether or not the same be incidental to some other business or occupation, and all persons conducting places of amusements, whether or not the same be incidental to some other business or occupation, at the rate of two (2) mills on each dollar of the volume of the annual gross business transacted by him.

(c) Wholesale and retail vendors or dealers in goods, wares and merchandise, at the rate of one and one-half (1-1/2) mills on each dollar of the annual gross wholesale business transacted by him and two (2) mills on each dollar of the volume of the annual gross retail business transacted by him.

SECTION 2. REPEALER

That any ordinance or part of ordinance, conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same affects this ordinance.
