

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 479, (AS AMENDED), FIXING
THE WAGES, SALARIES, VACATIONS AND SICK LEAVE OF
MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, AND PROVIDING
FOR THE APPOINTMENT, PROMOTION AND DISCHARGE THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

SECTION I. Article III, Section 6, shall be amended to include the following:

11. Election Day

SECTION II. Article IV, Section 4, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Sick Leave: Subject to other provisions of this ordinance, every employee shall upon the effective date of this Ordinance be entitled to seven and one-half (7-1/2) days sick leave to be applied against a maximum ninety (90) days sick leave computed over a sixty (60) month period as follows: Each employee shall be entitled to two (2) days of sick leave on the last day of each calendar month thereafter up to a maximum of one hundred twenty (120) days for a sixty (60) month period. All new employees shall accumulate sick leave at the rate of two (2) days at the end of each calendar month after commencement of employment. Only working days are included in applying sick leave to time off."

SECTION III. Article V, Miscellaneous Provisions, is hereby amended to include the following Section 12, "Longevity":

Section 12. Any employee not represented by a collective bargaining unit shall be entitled to the sum of \$125.00 after five (5) years of service with the Municipality with \$25.00 increments per year of service subsequent thereto to a maximum of \$500.00 after twenty (20) years of service.
