
A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE DIRECTING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO DISTRIBUTE A LETTER TO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, REQUESTING THEIR COOPERATION IN CONDUCTING TRAFFIC REVIEW OF NORTHERN PIKE, MONROEVILLE, PENNSYLVANIA.


WHEREAS THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE has received multitudinous complaints from local residents about traffic conditions on Northern Pike, from Patty Lane to the Turnpike Bridge Overpass, regarding many safety issues including inadequate sight distances of the side road on Northern Pike, the increasing high volumes of traffic using Northern Pike that add to the difficulty in entering and exiting side roads, and excessive speeds of vehicles traveling Northern Pike;

AND WHEREAS THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE has received a contribution from an existing business designated for improvements to the section of Northern Pike from Patty Lane to the Turnpike Bridge Overpass;

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, this 12th day of June, 2001, that the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville direct the Municipal Manager to prepare a letter to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, Traffic Division, requesting a Traffic Review be conducted of Northern Pike, from Patty Lane to the Turnpike Bridge Overpass, investigating the need for a traffic signal or other roadway improvements to address these existing problems.
