
A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,



APPLICATION FOR PERMIT  
TO INSTALL AND OPERATE

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville, Allegheny County  
(CITY, TOWNSHIP, BOROUGH)

desires to erect, operate and maintain traffic signals on Monroeville Blvd & Orchard Alley {  
\_\_\_\_\_, and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle Code requires the approval of the Secretary of Transportation before any  
traffic signals may be legally erected or reconstructed, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation requires an engineering drawing of the location,  
the Municipality of Monroeville will prepare such a drawing in conformance with the  
instructions provided by the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that traffic signals be erected at the above mentioned  
location, subject to the approval of the Secretary of Transportation, and that his approval is hereby  
requested, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, in the event a traffic signal permit is approved after proper  
investigation, the Municipality of Monroeville  
(CITY, TOWNSHIP, BOROUGH)  
will be bound by the following provisions:

The traffic signals shall be installed and maintained in accordance with the Vehicle Code and the  
Regulations for Traffic signs, signals and markings of the Department of Transportation, and

Should future highway or traffic conditions, or legal requirements, necessitate alteration of the  
construction or operation, or hours of operation, or removal of the traffic signals at the above mentioned  
location, they shall be altered or removed when and as directed by the Secretary of Transportation.
