Applicant is requesting Conditional Use Approval to install a billboard pursuant to Monroeville Zoning Ordinance, No. 1443, as amended, Section 307.14 *Billboards*. The property is located along William Penn Highway (Tax Parcel 743-J-297) in the C-2, Business Commercial, Zoning District. *(*Public Hearing)*

Good Shepherd Lutheran Church

The properties are located at the intersection of Old William Penn Highway and Old Haymaker Road in the R-1, One-Family Residential, and M-1, Planned Industrial, Zoning Districts.

Applicant is requesting Conditional Use Approval to establish a Non-Denominational Christian Church in an existing building pursuant to the Monroeville Zoning Ordinance, No. 1443, as amended, Section 401 and Table 201 C: Permitted Uses, Conditional Uses, Yard and Area Requirements. The property is located at 841 Old Frankstown Road in the R-2, One-Family Residential Zoning District, and known as tax parcel 975-S-128. (**Public Hearing*)


