CITIZENS' NIGHT MEETING

AUGUST 4, 2022

MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. by Mayor Nick Gresock.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND MOMENT OF SILENCE

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was observed. Mayor Gresock requested everyone keep Mr. Wolfram in their thoughts because of the recent passing of his father. He also mentioned Fred Manno who was a Monroeville Fire Fighter and Paramedic who recently passed.

MONROEVILLE LIBRARY

Mrs. Nicole Henline, Library Director, came forward to update council on the recent activity at the library and thank them for their continued support. She reported their circulation is rising and they are getting back to their pre-pandemic activity and are thrilled to bring back their after-school program this year. She expressed thanks to AmeriCorps and the Grable Foundation and the Helen Ruth Gordon Charitable Trust through the PNC Charitable Trust. She mentioned how the Summer read just ended and the attendance was good for the all-ages ice cream party. She reported they had the glass blowing demonstration thanks to a grant procured by the head of children's service. She explained the representatives from the Pittsburgh Glass Center were happy with the turnout of over 120 people.

Mrs. Henline reported they are bringing back the Funfest after a two-year hiatus because of the pandemic. She was hopeful they would have a strong return because they had 2,500 people who attended in 2019. She encouraged everyone to attend to see all the great things that they offer. She mentioned a petting zoo, magician, bounce houses, drum circle, painting, the robotics club, vendors, local legislators and special guests. She reported they are still looking for cupcake contest judges and encouraged everyone to volunteer.

Mrs. Henline reported September is Love Your Library Month and all donations to the Monroeville Public Library Fund will be part of a prorated match from the Buncher Foundation. She listed several fundraising opportunities during September including Trivia Night on September 17, 2022 and Chili-to-Go on September 25, 2022. She encouraged everyone to attend the Funfest and she disturbed invitations.
