ORDINANCE NO. 1893

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 25 OF ORDINANCE 1563, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1761, INCREASING THE FEE FOR AN APPLICATION FOR THE ERECTION OF TEMPORARY POLITICAL SIGNS FROM \$20.00 TO \$100.00; ESTABLISHING A REFUND OF \$80.00 FOR ALL TEMPORARY POLITICAL SIGNS REMOVED WITH FIVE DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville established a flat fee of \$20.00 for an application for the erection of temporary political signs; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has experienced a high rate of incidence of political candidates not removing their temporary political signs after election; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of increasing the fee for the application for the erection of temporary political signs and establish a refund policy which would refund to a political candidate the sum of \$80.00 if all the candidates temporary political signs are removed within five (5) days of each and every applicable election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 25 of Ordinance 1563 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 25. APPLICATION FOR SIGN PERMITS

- d. A flat fee of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars shall be charged for any application for the erection of temporary political signs. If all temporary political signs of a candidate who has filed the aforesaid application shall be removed from their place of erection within the Municipality of Monroeville within five (5) days from the date of any applicable election day, the sum of Eighty (\$80.00) Dollars shall be refunded to the applicant.

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.


