PROPOSAL FOR SMALL PAVING IN-PLACE

SPECIFICATIONS:

1. All items consist of paving of repairs in roadways, driveways, or parking lots on an as-needed basis.
2. Paving shall be performed in accordance with PennDOT Specification 408/2022 Change No. 7.
3. Bidder must utilize a self-propelled commercially manufactured paver capable of paving a width of 15 feet in a single pass with integrated 12" wide by 4-6" high wedge curb.
4. Bidder shall provide sufficient number and weight of steel wheel roller(s) to compact the mat.
5. Asphalt must be supplied by a PennDOT-approved asphalt plant in accordance with PennDOT Bulletin 41 and may contain no more than 15% RAP/ RAM. Job mix formulas for all materials must be provided to the Municipality prior to construction. Plant material slips must be provided to the Municipality for all asphalt placed.
6. All pavement depths/ thicknesses listed are compacted depths/ thicknesses.
7. All materials, labor, trucking, equipment, mobilization, fuel costs and any other costs not specifically mentioned are considered incidental and thus the Bidder should include those costs in the bid prices.
8. Item No. 1 – 4" Binder Course – Superpave 25.0 mm Binder Course, PG 64S-22, 0.0-0.3 million ESAL's, 4" Depth. This item consists of construction of a 4" thick 25.0 mm Superpave Binder Course. The Bidder will sawcut the existing pavement edges square or polygonal as directed by the Municipality, compact the aggregate subbase, place the binder course in one lift, and compact the binder course.
9. Item No. 2 – 5" Binder Course – Superpave, 25.0 mm Binder Course, PG 64S-22, 0.0-0.3 million ESAL's, 5" Depth. This item consists of construction of a 5" thick 25.0 mm Superpave Binder Course. The Bidder will sawcut the existing pavement edges square or polygonal as directed by the Municipality, compact the aggregate subbase, place the binder course in one lift, and compact the binder course.
10. Item No. 3 – 6" Binder Course – Superpave, 25.0 mm Binder Course, PG 64S-22, 0.0-0.3 million ESAL's, 6" Depth. This item consists of construction of a 6" thick 25.0 mm Superpave Binder Course. The Bidder will sawcut the existing pavement edges square or polygonal as directed by the Municipality, compact the aggregate subbase, place a 3" thick first lift, compact the lift, place a 3" thick second lift, and compact the second lift.
11. Item No. 4 – 1.5" Wearing Course - Superpave 9.5 mm Wearing Course, PG 64S-22, 0.0-0.3 million ESAL's, 1.5" Depth, SRL E. This item consists of construction of a 1.5" thick 9.5mm

Superpave Wearing Course only, no stone or binder is included in this item. Bidder will sawcut the existing pavement edges square or polygonal as directed by the Municipality, tack the vertical faces of the existing pavement, place the 1.5" wearing course, compact the wearing course, and seal the seam around the new pavement with PG 64S-22. The Bidder will not be responsible for trench settlement.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS OF BIDS:

1. Bidders must meet all of the following general requirements.
2. Check legal advertisement for date and time of bid opening.
3. Bid bond or certified check in the amount of ten (10) percent of the total bid is required. **A separate bid bond is required for each commodity bid.**
4. All bids held firm for sixty (60) days after bidding.
5. The Municipality will award bids on an individual line item basis.
6. **All bid prices, once accepted by Council, shall remain firm for a period of one (1) year from the award date with the following exception:**
 - a. Items 1-4 will be subject to the "Price Adjustment Of Asphalt Materials" Section 110.04, Publication 408/2020 Change No. 7, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Specifications. The price index IB will be as listed by PennDOT for March 2024 for Zone 3.
7. Bid prices must be delivered prices to any location with the Municipality of Monroeville unless otherwise stated.
8. Bid prices are to be free of any state, local or federal tax since the Municipality is a tax-exempt jurisdiction (tax-exempt certificate provided upon request).
9. The Municipality reserves the right to purchase more or less material than the estimated quantities listed above.
10. All sealed bids must be received by the Municipal Manager of the Municipality of Monroeville, 2700 Monroeville Boulevard, Monroeville, Pennsylvania 15146 by the published deadline and marked **SMALL PAVING IN-PLACE.**

11. Vendors supplying multiple bids are required to seal each and every bid individually, and clearly mark every envelope as to its contents. Once all of the bids are prepared they are to be placed in one single bid package, with all individual bids listed on the outside of the bid package.
