# REGISTRATION INFO

## HOW TO REGISTER

If you have not participated in an activity sponsored through the department you must complete and sign the "Household Information Form." Please provide all information requested on the form. Your registration will not be processed until all information is provided. Mail or fax your "Household Information Form" along with your "Program Registration Form" with payment to the Recreation, Parks, and Human Services Department.

## PAYMENT

No registrations will be accepted without full payment of fees. Cash, personal check, money orders, and credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, AmEx) will be accepted. No credit card information will be accepted over the telephone. Checks or money orders must be made payable to: "Municipality of Monroeville"

## REGISTRATION DEADLINE

All programs have been assigned a deadline date. All registrations submitted after this time will not be guaranteed admittance into the program and will be charged a late fee.

## LATE FEES

A \$10 late fee will be assessed to all registrations received after the assigned deadline date. Late fees apply to all registrations, regardless of residency.

## NON-RESIDENT FEES

Non-residents must pay a surcharge of \$10 for each registration. Priority is given to Monroeville residents. A non-resident fee will not be charged to Pitcairn residents for any activity held at a Gateway School facility.

## CANCELLATIONS/WEATHER POLICY

The Monroeville Recreation, Parks and Human Service Department reserves the rights to cancel, postpone, or reschedule any class due to lack of enrollment, inclement weather, or causes beyond our control. In the event of inclement weather please call our information hotline at 412.317.5070 for cancellations or early closing of facilities. If the Gateway School District is closed or will be closing early, all recreation programs held at the Gateway School facilities will be canceled. Every effort will be made to reschedule sessions missed due to unanticipated cancellations or postponements encountered during a program. Rescheduling is not guaranteed.

## REFUND POLICY

The decision to hold classes is based on enrollment. Refunds for recreation programs will be processed upon request in accordance with the following policy:

- Full refunds/credit will be issued if the MRPD cancels a program.
- All refunds must be submitted in writing before the first day of class. No refunds will be given after the first day of class.
- Cancellations prior to the deadline date will be given a full refund less a \$10 processing fee. After the deadline date, program voucher will be issued on a case-by-case basis.
- Participants assume the risk of changes in personal affairs or health.

# LEARN-TO-SWIM PROGRAM

## WHICH CLASS?

To ensure your child's success and safety in the Learn-to-Swim Program it is important to sign them up for the appropriate level. Children who have participated in the Learn to Swim Program should register according to the last class taken, based on successful completion. Each child should pass a particular level before proceeding to the next level. If you are new to the program, please see the course descriptions for each level.

## PASSING CLASSES

All children learn in different ways. It is natural for participants to develop motor skills and become comfortable with water at a different pace. It is not unsuccessful for a child to return to one particular level several times before masterful completion. All children are tested to make sure that they are in the appropriate class level on the first day of class.

## MISSED CLASSES

Classes missed for vacation, injury, sickness or any other reason can neither be made up, nor are they refundable. Every effort will be made to reschedule classes canceled by the Recreation, Parks, and Human Service Department; rescheduling is not guaranteed.

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

### LEVEL 1: INTRO TO WATER SKILLS

This level helps children feel more comfortable in the water. Children will learn to enjoy the water safely through submerging, floating, and elementary swimming skills.

### LEVEL 2: FUNDAMENTAL AQUATIC SKILLS

Children will learn fundamental skills of swimming through combined front and backstrokes, rotary breathing, gliding, underwater swimming, and treading water. Children must be able to demonstrate entering and exiting the water unassisted, bob five times to chin level, walk or swim along the gutter, and front float assisted for 3 seconds upon entering this level.

### LEVEL 3: STROKE DEVELOPMENT

This level helps to build on the skills learned in level two by providing additional guided practice. Children will learn skills such as front and back crawl, diving, breast and butterfly strokes.

### LEVEL 4: STROKE IMPROVEMENT

This level builds students confidence and performance of the swimming strokes learned in level three by providing additional guided practice. Children will learn deep-water skills, endurance and distance swimming. They will also begin to learn basic water safety techniques.

### LEVEL 5: STROKE REFINEMENT

This level builds on skills learned in level four by providing additional guided practice. Children will learn surface diving, turns, survival swimming, and how to increase endurance and the length of distance using previously learned strokes.



- **Swim goggles are required for all Preschool Swim, Learn to Swim, Adult Swim, and SNAP Programs.**
- **Snorkel swim masks are not permitted as they hinder learning necessary swim skills.**
- **If a student misses more than one lesson per session, they will be required to repeat the swim level.**




